Background and Objectives:

Following the adoption of Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction and the mandate given by member states to UNDRR to "support the implementation, follow-up and review" of the framework "by preparing periodic reviews on progress" (Article 48c), UNDRR Regional Office for Arab States has organized eight regional multi-stakeholder coordination meetings under the name "Arab Partnership Meetings for DRR" since 2018. These meetings bring together Arab governments, DRR stakeholders and regional UN agencies and international organizations.

The aim of the biannual Arab Partnership meetings for DRR has been to create a forum for technical and operational deliberation on the progress, challenges, and gaps in the implementation of the Sendai Framework in the region. Another key objective is to facilitate regional discussion on innovative solutions towards climate risk management and DRR integration in the SDGs in the Arab region. These periodic discussions on the implementation challenges, gaps and solutions intend to inform the deliberations of the Arab Regional Platform conferences.

In addition to its main objectives, the Ninth Arab DRR Partnership Meeting intends to mark the first step in the technical deliberations in preparation for the Sixth Arab Regional Platform for DRR, being hosted by the Government of Kuwait in October 2024. The 3-day meeting will also focus on discussions and agreements on sets of solid actions to take to operationalize the outcomes of the Midterm Review of Sendai Framework for DRR, the Arab-Africa Science and Technology for Disaster Risk Reduction Conference and the Global Resilience Forum. In addition, it will examine challenges and opportunities for expanding the roll out and financing of the Early Warning for All initiative in the Arab region, beyond the initial piloting in four LDCs.
